Amendment to Inquiry Direction No 10 – Preparation for and Conduct of Oral Hearings

In terms of section 17(1) of the <u>Inquiries Act 2005 ("the Act")</u>, which enables Lord Hardie ("the Chairman") to decide on the procedure and conduct of the Inquiry, he has directed as follows:

- 1. <u>Inquiry Direction No 10 Preparation for and Conduct of Oral Hearings</u> ("the Direction") dated 29 June 2017 regulates the conduct of the public hearings but requires amendment to reflect more accurately the intended procedure.
- 2. This Amendment is effective from the day after it is made and will remain in force until it is revoked or varied.
- 3. In paragraph 36 of the Direction in line 1 after the word "evidence", insert: "other than the evidence of expert witnesses".
- 4. Except insofar as varied by the amendment specified in the preceding paragraph, the provisions of the Direction will remain in full force and effect.
