Hi Natalie

I noticed that some of the signs for the Summer Solstice that I had removed had been attached to the fencing again on Friday..

Can you explain to me why this was done. I had already pointed out to you that due to Construction Regulations these signs were not permissible

. *The Contractor is expressly prohibited from displaying or allowing to be displayed any advertisement, notice, etc including illicit bill or fly posting on the hoardings. The Contractor shall ensure that all graffiti, fly posting or defacement to the hoardings is removed and made good or obscured within 24 hours.*

As you can see, we're unable to allow advertising to be displayed on the fencing, however, we believe directional signage is permissible, and have developed the directional signage protocol based on input from the contracts and the West End Focus Group

Can you explain to me why, despite being made aware of this you chose to ignore these regulations whilst at the same time (at our meeting) informing me that regulations would still apply to the traders. I find this arrogant and bullying.

Initially I thought that maybe someone was unaware of the regulations hence the erection of the signage, however when this was clearly pointed out to yourself you chose to conveniently ignore it not once but twice.

Please also advise on the cost of The Summer Solstice including the fee paid to Fred MacAuley. Myself and some of the other traders wish to know how the budget set aside to us is being spent
